Resident Spotlight: Meet Caroline

My name is Caroline and this is my story. I was homeless and as a result I was very unhealthy and mentally unstable. I felt like I was in a dark, dark place where no one understood me and no one knew how I felt. I was being controlled by my ex-boyfriend who spoke for me, so I had no voice. I slowly had erased who I really was.

When I was in recovery, a girl I lived with told me about St. Gianna's Place and how it was helpful for her. When I saw the place, I felt peace and acceptance. I felt like I was cared for for once in my life. It was a very happy feeling that made all my worries and everything that had been bothering me slowly fade away. I began to find my true self in a deeper and more meaningful way because of prayer and the programming offered at St. Gianna's Place. I also got outside counseling which helped me, too.

The workers here have been very helpful. Being a first-time mom is very scary. I had

no idea how to take care of a child. But the staff gave me help because I had issues with my son trying to calm down. Being a new mom is stressful. I felt a lot of support here at St. Gianna's Place. All the work the staff does here is out of love and support.

I needed to build up healthy relationships. It's been very helpful to meet these other residents that are in the same boat as me. They have similar stories here so we have been able to connect with one another. St. Gianna's Place is a very loving family and a great place to make long-lasting friends.
